


From the Pastor's Desk
16th Sunday of Ordinary Time: July 17, 2022

Last week after the three Sunday Masses, I appealed to the those present for volunteers to complement our regular ushering/greeting team. I referred to (and at one Mass introduced) a Parish Council member who is helping plan for a better system of greeting our visitors and newcomers. She recalls coming for the first time to OLOR and really needing to be embraced by the community in a personal way but it didn't happen. By God's grace, her personal devotion and eventually a kind hospitable regular from OLOR, she was enveloped in the love of both the Eucharistic AND Eclesial person of Jesus. (Remember that we, the Church, are his body and bride). The 7 volunteers, myself, and current ushers will attempt to ensure that we get it right the first visit of a 'guest' at Church. However, it behooves ALL of us who feel familiar and integrated into the parish family to act as good hosts as if we were welcoming Jesus himself... "I was a stranger and you invited me in" (Matthew 25:35). This will be the focus both prior to the commencement of the Mass and after its conclusion as we want focused and beautiful liturgy AND a warm and loving community of the baptized.

As with this weekend's Saturday building committee presentation after Mass, the coffee fellowship hosted by the Knights of Columbus AND the hot dog picnic on the office lawn for youth (10-15 years old's) after the Sunday Mass, you'll notice we're emphasizing community life as extension of the Sunday Mass. This is not a random strategy but reflects a fruitful emphasis on our most important 'activity' each week – namely Sunday worship. It's not that the mid-week activities are unimportant but they are superseded by the Lord's Day and the Lord's Supper. It makes immense practical sense too that we emphasize evangelizing, catechesis and community while we have our largest gathering of the week. Thank the Lord for the signs of renewal of the mission of Christ's Church so abundantly and joyfully evident each weekend.

One important mid-week initiative that flows from my Sunday Eucharist is an overnight trip to Tofino on Monday to participate in important First Nation reconciliation talks with a representative of the Church. My role is a humble one, basically a chauffeur and friendly presence, but a role I'm grateful to embrace. I would appreciate your prayers. With 3 weeks of summer holidays around the corner (August 2nd to 23rd), it is time to wind down some of the extraordinary events we've initiated until my return. I look forward to a staycation that will include our Diocesan family camp August 19-21, and other camping on the Island. Upon return you'll have the Pacheedaht Camp opportunity in Port Renfrew August 30th to September 1st, and the Metchosin farm Mass and Pic Nic September 4th. Longer term, remember the Westminster Abbey Advent Retreat, and in February the opportunity to join me on an incredible Holy Land pilgrimage. God is good! Fr. Dean
